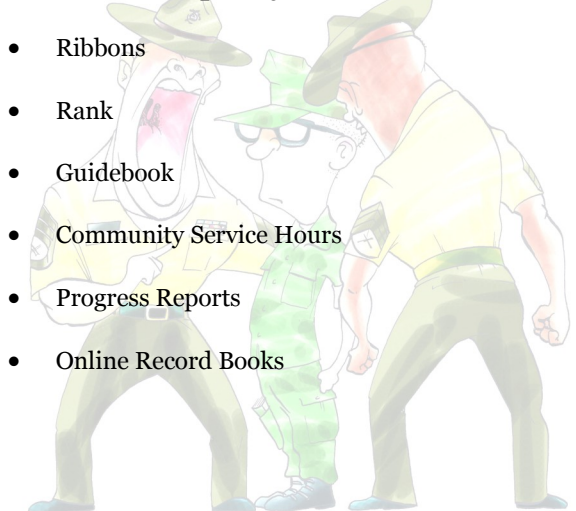

RIBBONS

Ribbons have been updated to the best of my knowledge. Please log into your record book and verify they are correct. (you will be instructed how to log on under the “record book” section of this publication. If there is a discrepancies please email me. The ribbon policy of this unit will be as follows, when you earn a ribbon the initial issue along with the certificate will be given to you. YOU are responsible for purchasing a new rack to add the additional ribbon. Devices earned for subsequent awards will also be issued when you complete the requirements. If you lose or damage a ribbon or device you may contact me and purchase a replacement ribbon or device. Ribbon and devices are \$1.00 each.

RANK

Ranks have also been update. Please verify that what I have in your record is correct. Any discrepancies please email me. **IMPORTANT** it is your responsibility to read your guidebook. You must notify me in person or by email when you feel you are ready to take the exam. It is every Young Marine’s responsibility to promote. The staff will give you all the tools you need to help you, but its up to YOU!



GUIDE BOOKS

Guidebooks have been ordered. When we receive the shipment, EVERYONE should be issued their current guidebooks at that time. It is important that you keep up with your guidebooks and learn the training objectives. Once you complete the reading and you feel you are ready for the exam, notify me and I can administer the test.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Did you know that anytime you do community service it counts towards your awards and promotion. The service does not have to be done as Young Marine or with the unit. For example, if you are a Boy Scout and you do community service with your troop all you have to do is fill out a community service Report (for copies contact me) and turn it in. PROGRESS REPORTS

ONLINE RECORD BOOKS

Effective immediately, all record books are available for view. To log in you will need to visit the website below.
